

1,020 fake Longchamp bags seized in house raid

PUTRAJAYA: A total of 1,020 counterfeit Longchamp handbags and pouch bags worth RM31,500 were seized in a raid on a house in Cheras, Kuala Lumpur, on Friday. Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Ministry's Enforcement Division director, Datuk Iskandar Halim Sulaiman, said the operation was carried out following complaints from a Longchamp's registered trademark owner on the online sale of counterfeit goods. "Checks showed that people were selling the counterfeit goods in some marketplaces at lower-than-usual prices," he said. The case is being investigated under Section 102 (1) (c) of the Trademark Act 2019, he said.
