

Mini mart manager fined RM1,000 for not fixing price tag

KULIM: A 30-year old mini mart manager was fined RM1,000 for not fixing price tags for sugar and cooking oil at the outlet in Sungai Karangan near here.

Kulim Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Ministry (KDPNHEP) enforcement chief Fazly Edros said the Pakistani man was issued the fine after enforcement officers conducted daily inspections around the Padang Serai area this morning.

He warned traders, especially in Kulim, Padang Serai and Bandar Baharu that stern action would be taken against them if they did not comply with existing regulations.

Fazly said enforcement officers had inspected over 2,932 premises this year, including looking into 60 complaints received.

He said 48 had been charged, RM11,497 worth of goods seized and RM14,500 in fines collected.
