

5 barbershops, salons receive KPDNHEP notice

MELAKA: The state Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Ministry (KPDNHEP) has issued notices to five barbershops and beauty salons in the state to ensure the prices offered were reasonable, especially during the Recovery Movement Control Order. Melaka KPDNHEP director Norena Jaafar said the notices sought to clarify certain service charges after inspections were made, besides receiving complaints of price increases ranging from RM5 to RM10 due to additional costs incurred by complying with standard operating procedures.
