

680 litres of diesel, lorry seized

MUKAH: The Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Ministry (KPDNHEP) branch here has seized 680 litres of diesel worth RM1,380.

Mukah KPDNHEP head Salihin Den said diesel was being filled into three drums on a lorry without any valid documentation or permit from the relevant authority last Friday.

He added that the diesel and the lorry were brought to the office for further action, while the driver was released after having his statement taken.

"The seizure was made under the Control of Supply Act, 1961," Salihin said during a press conference at the office here, yesterday.

He said the fuel station would be charged too for selling to a person with no valid documents.
