

Ministry seizes computers with pirated software

BUKIT MERTAJAM: The Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Ministry confiscated three computers and laptops containing pirated software worth RM7,000 in two operations here. Seberang Prai Tengah enforcement chief Ahmad Ahrazzuddin Ahmad-Hamdan said the operations were conducted on Wednesday and Thursday at two premises — an engineering company in Seberang Jaya and a construction business outfit in Seberang Prai. He said in the first operation, officers found an unlicensed copy of Autocad 2007 and Autocad Civil 3D 2017 in two computers. “The second case had devices that used unlicensed copies of Autocad 2016, Windows 10 Pro and Office Professional Plus 2013. All computers were seized for investigations,” he said yesterday.
