

Over 600 notices issued to salon owners

KUALA TERENGGANU: A total of 633 notices have been issued to barbershop and hair salon owners under Ops Catut 7.0 since the start of the recovery movement control order (MCO).

Deputy Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs (KPDNHEP) Minister Datuk Rosol Wahid said the notices were issued to seek clarification and feedback from the proprietors on the increase in ser-

vice charges at their premises.

He said they would be given three to five days to respond to the notice, failing which, action would be taken.

"So far, we have conducted inspections at 369 premises nationwide. In general, most of them have complied with the standard operating procedure under the recovery MCO.

"However, we had to issue notices

to premises owners who were found to have charged higher and unreasonable prices," he told reporters after reviewing prices and supply of goods at a supermarket in Kuala Terengganu City Centre yesterday.

Earlier, Rosol visited a barber-shop to check the pricing and compliance with the SOP. Also present was state KPDNHEP director Shahrudin Mohd Kia. — Bernama
