

# Two-week restriction

From tomorrow until March 31, Malaysia will be placed under an unprecedented nationwide movement control order to stem the spread of Covid-19. The move announced by Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin came after the country recorded 315 new cases in the last two days.
