

Saifuddin: Rumour mill going into overdrive on Pakatan-PAS union

KAJANG: It is a case of the rumour mill going into overdrive about an alliance between Pakatan Harapan and PAS, says PKR secretary-general Datuk Seri Saifuddin Nasution Ismail.

Any attempt to bring PAS into Pakatan would require the consensus of Pakatan component parties,

he said.

He was of the view that Pakatan did not need PAS as a new ally of the ruling coalition.

"I see it as a rumour but I do not see the reasons for Pakatan to accept new membership," he told reporters yesterday.

Earlier, Saifuddin officiated the

pre-launch of the Food Collection and Distribution Centre for the Food Bank Malaysia Programme in Bukit Angkat, Kajang here.

Rumours have been swirling around about a possible alliance between Pakatan and PAS.

Yesterday, Parti Amanah Negara deputy president Datuk Seri

Salahuddin Ayub was reported as saying that there was no need for Pakatan to bring PAS onboard.

Amanah is a splinter of PAS.

Pakatan is made up of PKR, DAP, Bersatu and Amanah while PAS has forged an alliance with Umno in the hope of unseating Pakatan in the next general election. — Bernama
