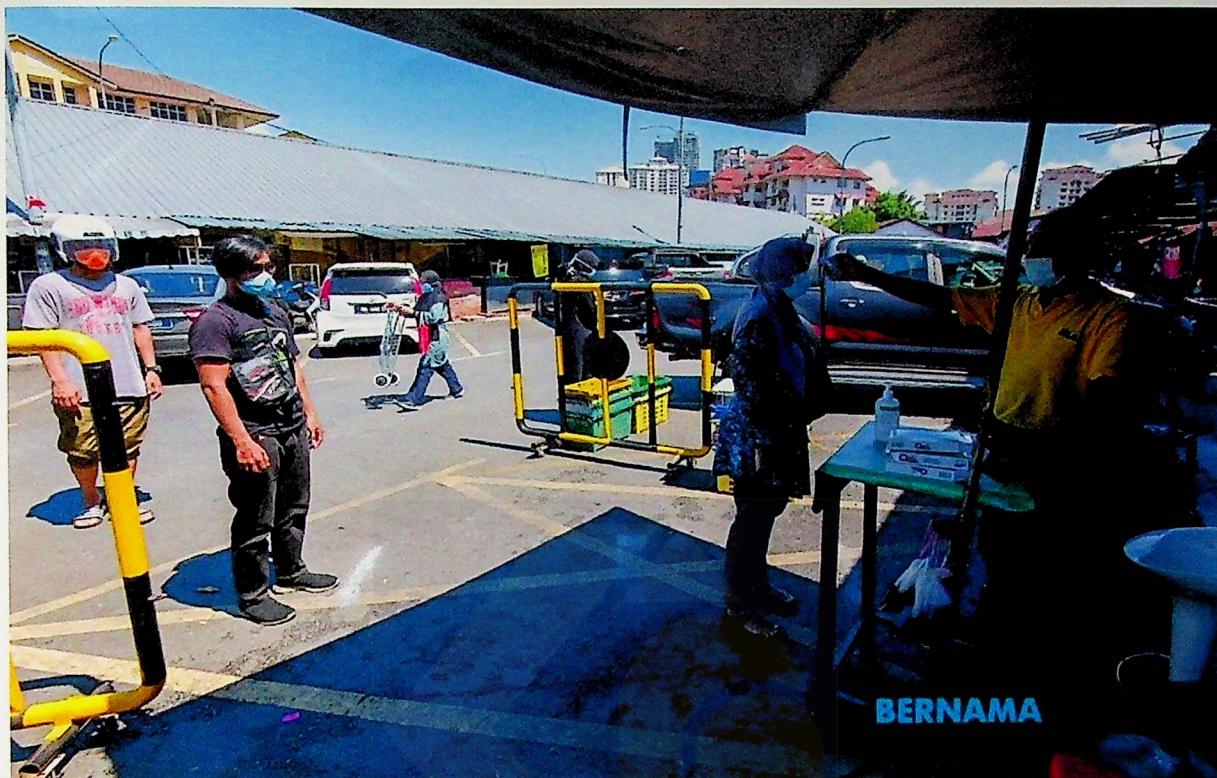




Pekerja kedai runcit, Ismail Abdullah membuat pemeriksaan suhu badan pelanggan sebelum membenarkan mereka masuk

Peniaga wajib patuh undang-undang sepanjang PKP

KUALA LUMPUR, 12 April -- Kementerian Perdagangan Dalam Negeri dan Hal Ehwal Pengguna (KPDNHEP) hari ini memaklumkan bahawa tindakan penguatkuasaan terhadap peniaga terus dipertingkatkan sepanjang Perintah Kawalan Pergerakan (PKP).

KPDNHEP dalam satu kenyataan media menyatakan tindakan pemeriksaan dijalankan di pelbagai peringkat pemborong, pasar raya besar serta peruncit termasuk kedai biasa dan pasar basah serta penalti tinggi akan dikenakan sekiranya berlaku pelanggaran undang-undang itu.

"Sejak PKP dikuatkuasakan bermula 18 Mac lepas, 881 premis diperiksa di seluruh ibu negara. Ini untuk memastikan bekalan mencukupi dan peniaga patuh kepada undang-undang khususnya melibatkan tanda harga dan tidak mengambil kesempatan mencatut," jelas kenyataan itu.

Menurut kenyataan itu lagi, pemeriksaan di pasar basah harian Selayang pagi semalam merekodkan tiga kesalahan kerana gagal mempamerkan tanda harga barangan yang dijual dan peniaga itu ditawarkan kompaun serta merta berjumlah RM400.

Ismail Sabri, who is also Defence Minister, said this at a media conference after a Special Ministerial Committee meeting on the MCO here today.

In a related development, Ismail Sabri said KPDNHEP had conducted checks on essential items nationwide to determine the level of availability for 25 preferred consumer items.

As of yesterday, some 1,025 checks were carried out involving retailers, wholesalers and producers. "Based on checks in grocery stores, almost all essential items are at a stable availability level and this includes face masks and sanitisers," he said.

He said KPDNHEP had also received 8,145 consumer complaints and queries between March 18 and April 11 via four channels, namely WhatsApp (4,140) E-Aduan (1,766) Hotline (1,631) and its Enforcement Command Center (608).

Ismail Sabri said the Agriculture and Agro-based Industry Ministry (MOA) has also informed that supply of perishables and dry goods, rice in particular, was sufficient. – Bernama
