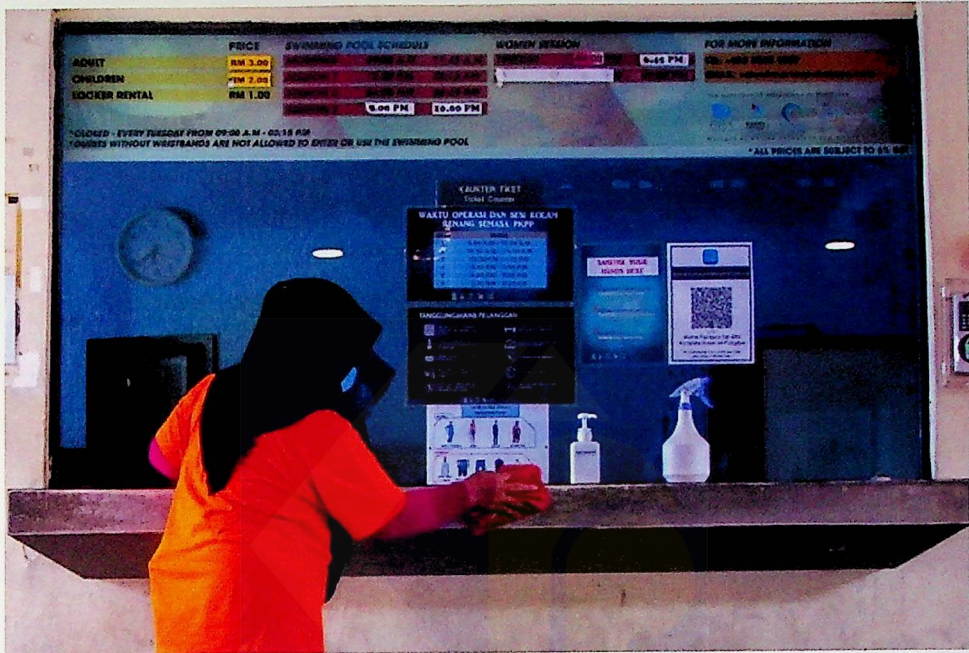


## 9 premises owners given advice for non-compliance of SOP

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Nine premises owners were given advice for non-compliance of the Recovery Movement Control Order's (RMCO) Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) during checks by the Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Ministry (KPDNHEP).

Senior Defence Minister Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob said KPDNHEP enforcement personnel conducted 1,368 compliance checks and found full adherence of the SOP at 1,359 premises yesterday.

He said the KPDNHEP enforcement team also carried out checks on the supplies of 25 essential items at 845 business premises yesterday.

He said the checks covered, among others, retailers (639), wholesalers (175) and factories (31).

"Overall, there are sufficient supplies to cover public needs. The Agriculture and Agro-based Ministry is also conducting surveillance at the production level to ensure sufficient supplies," he said in a statement today.

Ismail Sabri then reminded the public to maintain social distancing and good personal hygiene as preventive measures against the Covid-19 virus.
