FUEL SUBSIDY FINE TUNED

GEORGE TOWN: The government is fine tuning its targeted fuel subsidy for the B40 (lower-income) group. Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Minister Datuk Seri Saifuddin Nasution Ismail said data was being cross-checked to ensure only those eligible received the subsidy. Once completed, he said the paper would be tabled to the Cabinet and if approved, an announcement would be made on implementation. In Budget 2019, it was stated that owners of cars 1,500cc and below or motorcycles 125cc and below will be eligible for RON 95 petrol subsidy. – Bernama
