

Enough essential items during MCO, rural folk assured

KAPIT: The Ministry of Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs assures the longhouse folk at Nanga Merit and upper Merit that there is enough essential food items to last until the end of the movement control order (MCO) on April 14.

The ministry has opened two 'points of sales' in the area which are manned by appointed retailers, where the people could get their supply. The ministry is subsidising the transportation cost of sending the goods to these POSes under the Subsidised Goods Price Unification Programme.

Its chief enforcement officer here Al Redzamani Abdul Razak said the POSes have enough items such as rice, sugar, cooking oil, flour, LPG cylinders, petrol and diesel.
