

Over RM1 million in goods seized by KPDNHEP Miri this year — Enforcement chief

MIRI: Continuous effort by the Miri office of the Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Ministry (KPDNHEP) has led to the seizure of goods worth over RM1 million from 132 offenders between Jan 1 and Aug 22 this year.

This was disclosed by KPDHHEP Miri enforcement chief Joe Azmi Jamil, who said the seizures were made over various trade offences, which also saw offenders issued with compounds totalling RM16,300.

"The 132 offenders were booked from a total of 8,111 premises inspected during the period, which included 7,366 premises in urban centres and 745 premises in rural areas," he said during an appreciation dinner with members of the media from Miri and Limbang, held here recently.

He said nine cases valued at over RM985,000 were recorded under the Supply Control Act 1961, followed by 39 cases under the Weights and Measures Act 1972 which involved seizures valued at RM20,840 and compounds of RM4,900.

The rest of the offences were under the Price Control and Anti-Profiteering Act 2011, Trade Description Act 2011 and Consumer Protection Act 1999, he added.
