

Just a 'trim', eh? 635 notices issued to barbers, beauty salon operators for alleged profiteering

PUTRAJAYA (Bernama): The Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Ministry has issued a total of 635 show-cause notices to barbers, hairdressers and beauty salons nationwide over suspicions of profiteering.

Its minister Datuk Alexander Nanta Linggi (pic) said the show-cause notices issued to operators also serve as a warning for them to comply with the law.

"Those notices were issued prior to the implementation of the movement control order (MCO) and during the recovery MCO.

"Those who fail to submit the notices within the stipulated period or are found to be profiteering will face stern action under the Price Control and Anti-Profiteering Act 2011," he told Bernama here Tuesday (June 16).

He said that since the implementation of the recovery MCO starting June 10, the ministry had carried out enforcement under Ops Catut 7.0 by targeting these service providers to prevent profiteering. – Bernama
